Academic Excellence in Grade 7 & Grade 9: We are thrilled to report a 100% pass rate for both our Grade 7 and Grade 9 students. The Grade 7 cohort comprised 62 students, while Grade 9 has 63 students.

When compared to national performance statistics – Grade 7 (Lifesong: 100% vs. National: 71.19%) and Grade 9 (Lifesong: 100% vs. National: 55:89%) – our students have demonstrated outstanding achievements.

This success is a testament to the dedication of our leadership, teaching staff, chaplaincy, and house parents. Our holistic approach to education continues to yield remarkable results, setting Lifesong Harmony Schools apart from public institutions. We eagerly anticipate receiving the Grade 12 results in January 2025.
