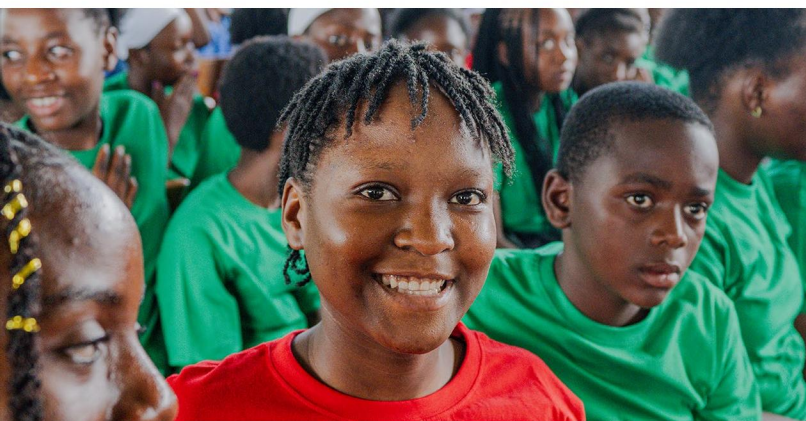
### Celebrating Christmas Together
